- 1) A reference book with plans of the layout and photos of the memorials may be borrowed for a couple of hours on Monday or Tuesday mornings by appointment.
- 2) Memorials must have an adequate depth of soil around them removed, the memorial to be set upright and secured with a dry mix of concrete.
- 3) It is planned to award the contract in 2017 but it will be subject to a successful application for a Faculty from the Diocese.
- 4) The successful applicant may not start work until informed of a start date by the council as it intends to apply to the National Park for a Community Grant. If successful, the council will probably know in spring.
- 5) Subject to a successful Faculty application, the work must be completed by the 31st August 2018.
- 6) Deadline for quotations: Monday 30th October 2017 at noon.
