| <p>a) To note that the clerk submitted an application for a Community Payback Team (CPT) to assist with moving soil and tidying work in the cemetery and that they have agreed to work in the Old Cemetery following a meeting with Councillor Marsden and some of the volunteers.</p> <p>b) To consider purchasing large bags of soil and to agree an approximate budget.</p> <p>c) To consider changing the way Cemetery Fees are calculated in 2019 so that they reflect the administration and maintenance costs rather than the Parochial Church Council Fees, which usually have other fees collected by the Church added.</p> <p>d) To consider having much of the unused areas of grass in the new cemetery cut 12 or 15 times a year by Allgardens for £25 per cut in 2019.</p> |

| <p>e) To consider suspending the Cemetery Rules and to consider a request for a block of at least 9 burial plots in the eastern corner, which will have space for cremation plots (not calculated), and if the council agrees to consider:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The number of plots that can be reserved.• The cost per plot if paid in 2018 and in 2019.• Whether a boundary will be allowed – a narrow yew hedge has been requested which the family will plant and maintain. The funeral and interment for the first cremation plot is on Monday 29th October. <p>f) To consider amending the Cemetery Rules to allow residents of Helmsley civil Parish, which includes Carlton, who are on the electoral roll for Helmsley, to reserve a burial plot if they are over an age to be agreed, perhaps 70, and to agree the fees for a reservation.</p> |
